ABOUT US: Wildside Community Camp

- Wildside Community Camp is a one-week Girl Scout volunteer-led resident camp, est.1992.
- This camp is held at Camp Lyle McLeod which is owned and operated by Girl Scouts of Western Washington and is located on the Kitsap Peninsula just outside of Belfair.
- Camp Lyle McLeod has a lodge, a swim dock, a boat dock, an archery range, a craft loft and numerous camping villages surrounding the tree-lined shores of beautiful Lake Bennettsen.
- Program areas operated by certified volunteers include boating, swimming, and archery. Additional specialty programs include arts & crafts, songs/guitar, outdoor skill-building, group games, and much more. Activities are loosely based on a central theme, changed each summer.
- Experienced adult GS leaders oversee individual unit "villages" each comprised of a large cook shelter, a group fire circle, and sleeping cabins. All camp volunteers receive pre-camp training.
- A certified healthcare professional is available at the onsite Health House during camp and oversees the care and safety of all participants.
- Parents and guardians are responsible for transportation to and from camp. In case of emergency, illness, severe homesickness, or behavior problems, parents will be notified by a phone call and may be expected to come to camp early to pick up their camper.
